Archdiocese of Toronto Jubilee Pilgrimage to Martyrs' Shrine – Sunday, August 24, 2025

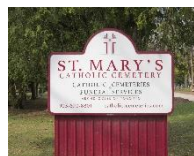

St. Kateri Tekakwitha: A Story of Devotion to God

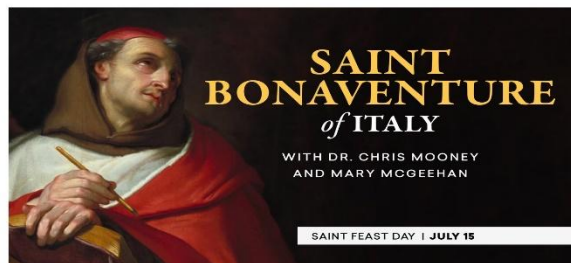

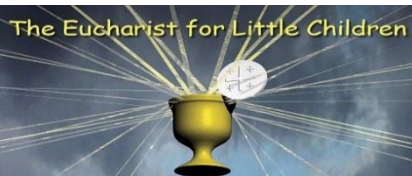
