Wondering where our white cross has gone? Its base had rotted, so our plan is to repair it and have it re-installed in the future.

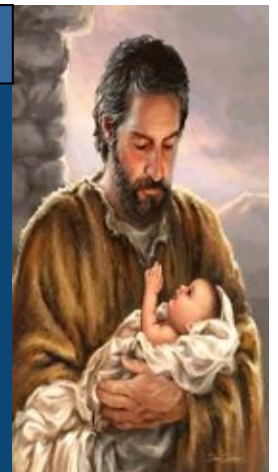


Martyrs' Shrine Centennial Anniversary – June 27th

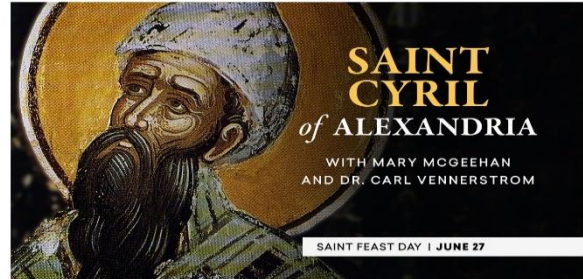

St. Cyril of Alexandria | Catholic Saints

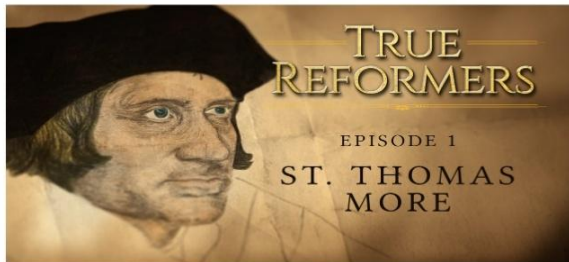

Saint Thomas More: The Age of the Author

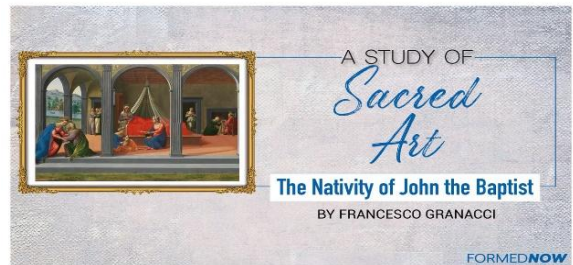

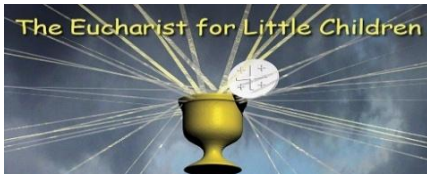
