Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59, fast by eating one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to the full meal. Catholics 14 years of age and older, abstain from meat to remind us of the sacrifice of Jesus.

### The Total Gift: A Katharine Drexel Story | Trailer



### Sts. Perpetua




