Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. Catholics aged between 18 and 59, fast by eating one full meal and two small meals that don't add up to a full meal. Catholics 14 years of age and up, abstain from meat to remind us of the sacrifice of Jesus.

St. Frances






