A reminder that the date for Confirmation is also coming up on May 25th at 11:00am and 2:00pm.





This six-part series will help families to learn how to:


- 1. Faithfully take their families to Sunday Mass, even in difficult seasons

- 6. Raise the next generation of saints, even today




