Holy days of obligation are feast days on which Catholics are required to attend Mass. Canada has two holy days of obligation: **December 25<sup>th</sup>, the Solemnity of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ and January 1<sup>st</sup>, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.**

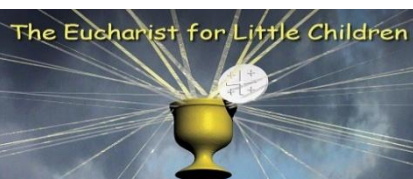
